I have played the violin since I was 12, sketching since I can remember, and I love baking.





Mark is an associate with a few different Global Fashion Magazines and is a freelancer with Media 24 as a Photo Journalist and a Cinematographer for News 24.



His name is Stanley Cierenberg, Word and Voice artist. He writes short stories and tells the world about love and hate, sunshine and rain.



Daniel Jooste/Chuckie - TRO (The real Ones) For Chuckie It all started about 20 years ago. Together with Paul Ogle, Emlyn Barlow, and Fabian Peters, "THE REAL ONES" better known as TRO was a Newlands East Durban based Hip Hop group formed around the early 90's, with a desire to educate people about life in the streets of an average South African neighbourhood.

TRO took first prize in the Seagrams / Radio Metro African Hip Hop competition in 1995. They went on to release their first effort in 1996 which featured tracks like "Da Bruinfunk", "Catch n Wakeup" and the smash hit song "Hey Owens" The Group was well know across the country for creating their own lyrical genre known as "BRUINFUNK" which is a combination of slang commonly used by certain communities across South Africa. TRO released their 2nd effort under Gallo Records which was Titled "PlayTimesOver" With the loss of a best friend and fellow TRO member in 2001 Funky Fabian, together with record company politics, members started drifting apart and focusing on solo careers which saw the members collaborating with other well known South African artists.

For Chuckie, the transition from band member to solo artist was a smooth one. In early 2002 he started penning 'My Baby' which was to be his first song release as a solo artist since TRO. The song was a mix of R&B, Rap and smooth vocals.

At the same time a compilation was being put together where some of the most talented young stars got their chance to shine. 'My Baby' featured well known South African R&B Artist Verd. The song was added to the cd and 'East Coast Flava' Was born. Over the years he performed with big named South African artists like TKZee, Mandoza, Chiskop, Trompies and Boom Shaka as well as slot to open up for international artists such as Ludacris and Kelly Roland.

In early 2005 Chuckie packed his bags and headed for the UK. Taking some time away from the music industry for a few years to gather his thoughts and try his hand at other business ventures.

It wasn't long before he would return to what he loved and enjoyed doing. In 2009 Chuckie realized that he could not stay away from his first love, Music. He started buying recording equipment, set up his own studio, put his producing skills to full effect and started producing his own tracks. He then released a series of songs such as "Where I'm from", I Also Want", "Moogoos" "Salute" and a tribute to Fabian titled "Dear Fabian" which he made available to the public for free via social media.

Chuckie returned to South Africa after being in the UK for 6 years and started his own independent Record Label called "Bfoked Nation" which boasts two of Durban's elite MC's, Jet Wentworth and fellow TRO member TSO. After returning to SA there has been an overwhelming amount of requests for TRO and East Coast Flava to perform and for the past few years Chuckie together with some of the fellow members from TRO and East Coast Flava has been on the road performing with each year growing momentum and doing more shows across South Africa and some neighboring countries. 2015 saw TRO embarking on their first international Tour to Australia which they dubbed "AusTROlia" After 2015 Chuckie has released a series of music which has been

received well by his core followers built up throughout his music Career since he started in 1994... "No Flops" Ft Jet Wentworth and TRO partner TSO, "Pressure" ft B. I. P the street anthem "Dusted" ft Biggie and the Ever Popular hip hop song by Riggz who ft Chuckie called "The Way We Choon"... Today you can still find Chuckie and TRO highly active and remains one of the only acts from their era who are still performing live shows...

In 2020 TRO was honored by the City of Durban with the Honoray Award for their contributions to the South African Music industry... There is no doubt that Chuckie has his feet firmly planted in the music industry and will continue to give good quality music with an international sound.

The music is undoubtedly Hip Hop, Rap and R&B but there is no mistaking the Bruin-Funk flow. Since the pandemic TRO has been performing regularly across South Africa with fellow musicians such as Verd, Jae, Riggz, Sir Linho among others.

"I am thrilled to be working on these new projects.


I hope my readers will enjoy the journey these books will take them on as much as I have enjoyed writing them."








2. What made you enter this profession?

Sometimes it all just feels like one blob, and I sit with myself like, "okay Wanda but where was the beginning?" - Here's the thing, I'm

undoubtedly led by my intuition, and as soon as I allowed myself to trust it, it's saved my life over and over again. I find myself making decisions, not really understanding the full picture but feeling so convicted and trusting that. So, let's track back together for a second. I would take part in our high school's annual Play Festival; I believe this was my introduction to the art of actina specifically. I loved it and eventually took drama as one of my official subjects. I later went on to major in theatre and performance studies at The University of Cape Town. Now I wouldn't say I knew exactly what I wanted to do with this degree, but it was the only course I was willing to take because nothing else made sense to me, it was performance or nothing. I didn't finish acting school, but ironically when I left was the first time, I took practical steps in pursuing my acting career because I knew I was neglecting a huge part of my artistic expression. The Woman King was a very pivotal moment for me because as terrifying as it was and sometimes still is, it was the first time I allowed myself to confidently say YES to being

an actor. Before that I was pursuing this dream but a huge part of me didn't fully feel "equipped" to live it out in reality which I don't think is true but unfortunately that's what fear and imposter syndrome can do.

3. How long have you been doing it?

I've always been a performer. My family is pretty social and growing up we were encouraged to dance at gatherings. I knew if I shut it down, I'd get showered with money once I entered the circle so that was great motivation, and I'd do just that! But upon reflection I can observe my genuine love for entertainment. I have pictures of my 6th birthday party where I was shutting it down on the dance floor, I simply wanted to do just that, entertain. This must have been my introduction to performance...at home, in those circles. As I got older, I started tapping into my musicality. I sang... a lot, mostly through choir. I love group work, I love community and mostly I love music, and choral singing involved all these elements. I would go on to sing under the direction of acclaimed conductor Hendrik D. Loock, in The Tygerberg Children's Choir and later André vd Merwe, in the renowned Stellenberg Girls Choir. In the world of choral music, these were incredibly prestigious choirs that took me on an enormous musical journey that essentially changed my life. I believe this is where I truly fell in love with performance as a whole.

Wanda is a passionate advocate for social change and encourages necessary conversations that promote inclusivity and diversity in the industry and society all together.

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

I think we need to have more honest conversations around the journey behind success or what we view as success right. I often get asked for "The Steps", how do you "make it" essentially and I let out a soft giggle because for artists I don't think there is a one-way ticket to success. For me, it's been a long journey of trial and error and honestly behind my personal successes lie a plethora of disappointments, redirections and many nos. So, the first piece of advice I'd give to anyone interested in pursuing performance is that they have to release attachment to "making it" immediately.

Of course, sometimes it happens that way, but it can take a lot of auditioning and putting yourself out there, believing in yourself first before someone else does and maintaining consistency before you get that role that changes your life perhaps. I think that's the blockage because our journeys as artists/creatives are so vast in how they come to be. It's a tad bit tricky because it feels quite abstract right, but I do think there are tools out there that lead us somewhat in the right direction. And that's where the practical part comes to play. Whether that's joining an agency or getting someone to manage you, it's important to enter that world and be in the orbit of the industry. Once you start auditioning, and getting a feel of this new world, the puzzle slowly starts putting itself together, and I believe that's how our journey's become unique. Lastly, I'd say it's important to remain authentic to oneself as you

1. What is your full name/company name and title/profession? Marc Hardwick / The Guardian / Managing Director / Specialist Child Abuse Investigator.

2. What made you enter this profession/ establish your company?

I started as a SAPS member of the then Child Protection Unit which is now called FCS.

3. How long have you been doing it/been in business?

25 years working in Child protection. Guardian started in 2009.

4. What was the most difficult part of this journey?

There have been many challenges, emotional, physical, financial. Running a business isn't easy and this field is very emotionally taxing. I'd have to say the greatest challenge is the fact that people, parents, schools, sports clubs, live in the space of "It won't happen to me" and changing that mindset is extremely difficult.

5. What has been the most exciting and/or rewarding moment of this journey?

There have been many wins along the way, but I think self-satisfaction after getting a conviction combined with the gratitude of a survivor probably tops most of the highs.

6. Please elaborate on safety advice and steps that need to be taken to be The Guardian-approved.

This is quite a difficult question. Firstly, we're

referring to safeguarding not safety. Safety is more of a tick box. Setup evacuation processes, make sure fire hydrants work. Safety is generally protection from the environment. Safeguarding is creating structures and reporting mechanisms that reduce the possibility of toxic relationships developing such as bullying, sexual harassment, sexual assault, inappropriate online and real-world relationships, grooming etc. Safeguarding isn't an action, it's a process. It's changing the culture of an environment. Only those who commit to changing the culture will truly safeguard the vulnerable. Doing clearances and education and having policies are vitally important but they become window dressing unless someone takes responsibility for changing the culture of the industry or environment. It can't happen overnight. The solutions mentioned above only become effective if safeguarding in the organisation becomes "Sexy".

7. What advice can you give to anyone interested in going into this profession?

Doing what we do isn't rewarding in the traditional context. Theres no award for the best Designated Safeguarding Officer (DSO). Being a DSO won't make you popular, and if you are genuinely effective, genuinely driven to making a change, you will probably "piss people off" when you implement those changes.



MANAGING DIRECTOR / SPECIALIST CHILD ABUSE INVESTIGATOR

Successful safeguarding means that there are effective safeguarding strategies and the vulnerable are affected less by any level of abus and when no one is abused no one knows you exist. When something does go wrong and it doe end up on your desk, you cannot share any details. There is no accolades for being an amazing DSO, other than the fact that "They a safer because of you". They probably don't and never will know it, but if going to bed knowing that the vulnerable are safer because of you, ar that gets you up in the morning, then this work may be a consideration.

8.What is the secret to your success (if you are willing to share)?

My success? I don't know if I have achieved that believe and pray that I am steering The Guardian on the right track, but unless the num ber of cases against the vulnerable starts reducing, I feel like we are just putting out fires. There was a time when I chased paedophiles and thos that hurt children. I feel I got quite good at it ar
